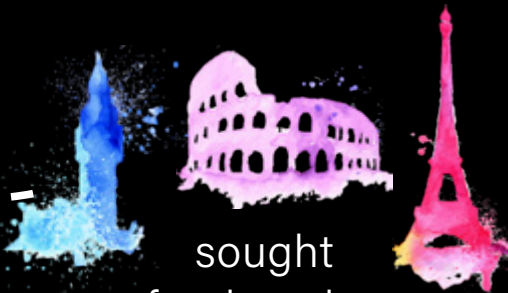

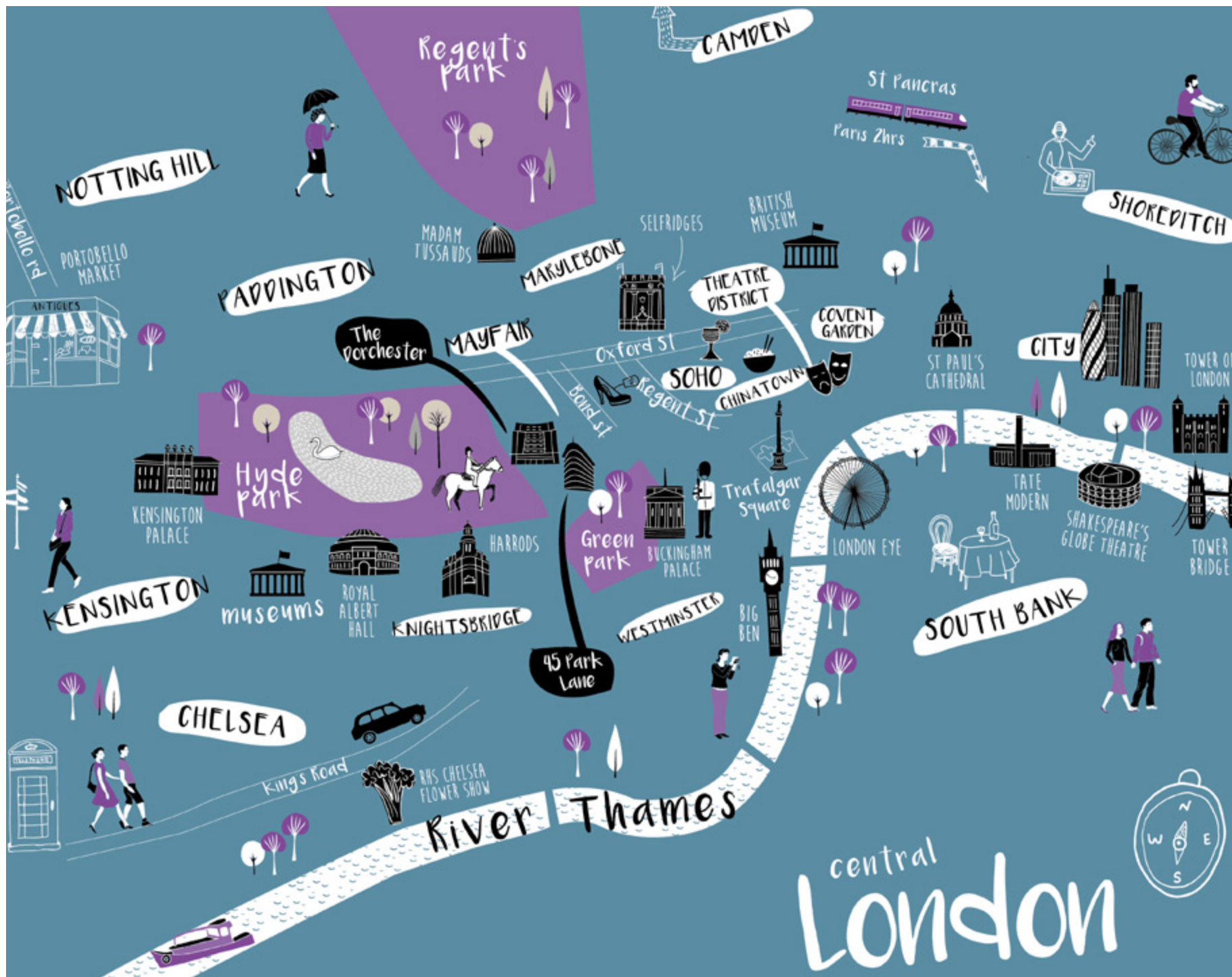

# DISCOVER LONDON

With its unique and vibrant blend of history and culture, London offers visitors an eclectic range of museums, galleries, public parks and attractions. As one of the gourmet capitals of the world, new restaurants, clubs and bars are opening in London all the time, so there are plenty of reasons to come back again and again.

## ARTS & CULTURE

Widely regarded as a hotbed of contemporary artistic practice, London has hundreds of small private galleries located in and around Mayfair and St James. A vibrant gallery scene can be found on nearby Cork Street and further east in Shoreditch and Hackney, while the Frieze Art Fair takes place every October in nearby Regent's Park.

Major collections and exhibitions can be seen at the Saatchi Gallery, Tate Modern, Tate Britain, the National Gallery, National Portrait Gallery, Royal Academy of Arts and the Design Museum. London also has a rich selection of museums – many of which are only a short distance from the hotel, such as the British Museum, Victoria and Albert Museum (V&A), Natural History Museum and the Science Museum.

## THEATRE & MUSIC

Many of London's West End theatres, the Royal Albert Hall, Royal Opera House and the English National Opera are just a short ride from the hotel. Shakespeare's Globe, The National Theatre and the Southbank Centre are all nearby.

## ATTRACTIONS

The Dorchester is close to the majority of London's most popular attractions such as Buckingham Palace, the Houses of Parliament, Big Ben and Westminster Abbey. Located opposite The Dorchester, Hyde Park is the city's largest Royal Park. It's home to the Diana, Princess of Wales, Memorial Fountain and the Serpentine Gallery. Visitors can also enjoy a range of leisure activities including jogging, tennis, horse-riding, and boating on the Serpentine.

## SHOPPING

Near the hotel, discover London's most exclusive shopping areas such as New Bond Street, Old Bond Street, South Molton Street, Knightsbridge, Sloane Square and Chelsea. With a wide range of leading brands, high street names and specialist retail outlets, Oxford Street, Regent Street, Piccadilly and Covent Garden are also within walking distance.

The Eurostar terminal at St Pancras is only ten minutes by car. 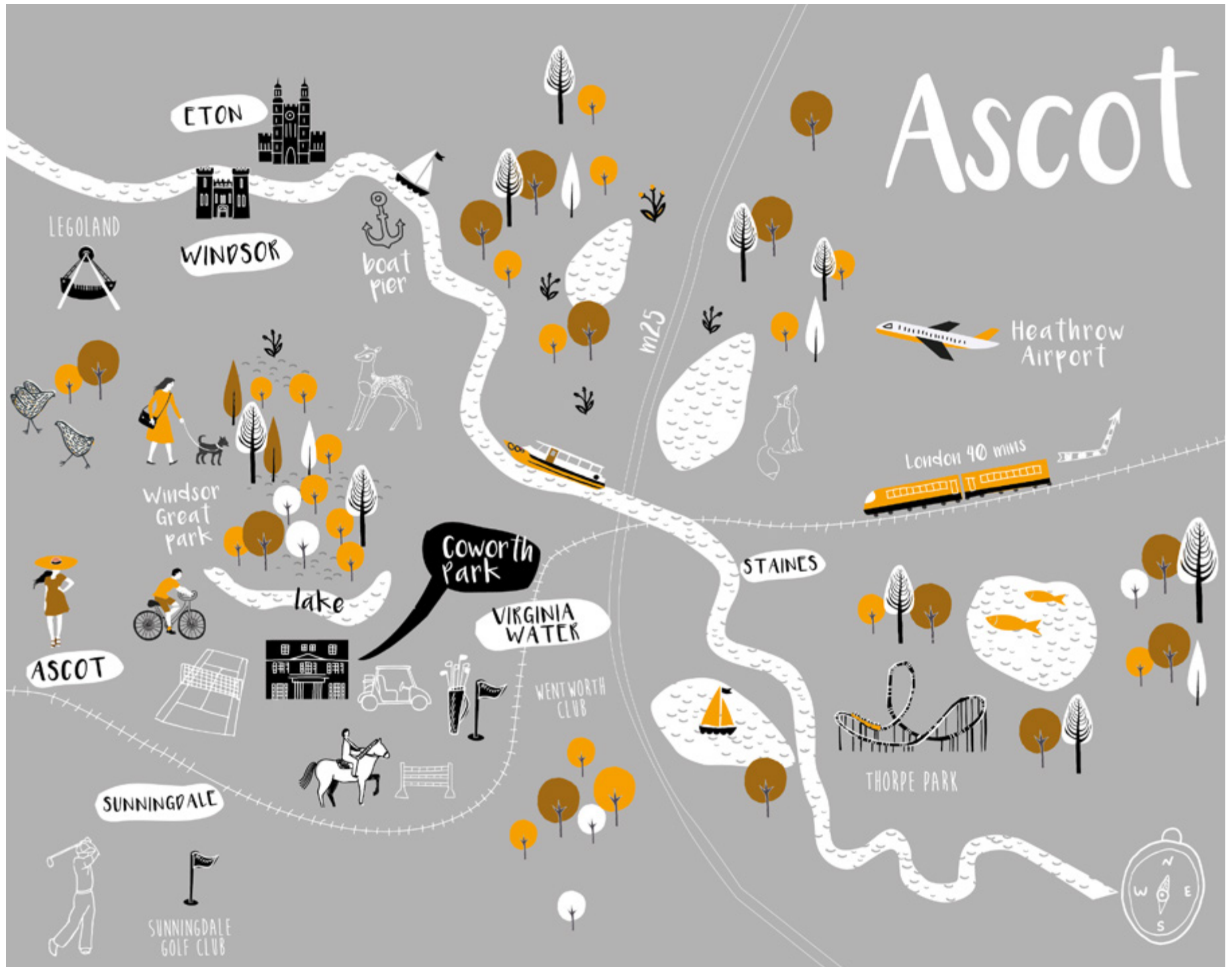

# DISCOVER THE COUNTRYSIDE

With 240 acres of picturesque parkland, an equestrian centre, polo fields, a kids' club and plenty of outdoor pursuits, Coworth Park has more than enough to keep even the most active guest entertained. Nearby you can also discover breathtaking vistas, cultural gems and heritage sites in the local Berkshire towns and countryside.

## EQUESTRIAN CENTRE AND POLO

Equestrian at Coworth Park provides stabling for up to 40 horses, with an experienced team of trainers offering support for beginners and seasoned riders alike. Coworth Park is the only UK hotel to feature its own polo fields and practice facilities, managed by Guards Polo Club.

## COUNTRY PURSUITS

Walking and jogging maps are available from reception, and a broad range of outdoor sports and pursuits are offered including horse-riding, archery, laser clay pigeon shooting, falconry, mountain biking, tennis and croquet. Guests can also look forward to delicious picnics in the grounds, tailored to the individual's taste.

## THEME PARKS
