London, June 27, 2024 – Dorchester Collection's global portfolio of iconic hotels are redefining summer luxury with a curated collection of new bespoke experiences. Guests can enjoy an exclusive Dioriviera pop-up at The Beverly Hills Hotel and indulge in new culinary concepts at Hotel Bel-Air in Los Angeles, or discover floral displays at The Dorchester and an alfresco 'Bubbledogs at 45' pop-up at 45 Park Lane across the pond in London. Other European experiences include revitalising new wellness treatments and Olympics programming at Hotel Plaza Athénée and Le Meurice in Paris, and an elite yachting excursion from Hotel Eden in Rome. Meanwhile in Dubai, at newly opened The Lana, guests can immerse themselves in a haven of art and gastronomy.

THE BEVERLY HILLS HOTEL, BEVERLY HILLS

Following last year's success, The Beverly Hills Hotel welcomes back its captivating collaboration with Dior this summer. Guests can once again discover the joy of escape and 'art de vivre' with the pop-up boutique showcasing the new Dioriviera capsule collection. Inspired by the allure of a Mediterranean beach vacation, this immersive poolside takeover features a curated selection of classic Dior decor in bright, coral-pink fabrics. New this year, Dior also has a residency within the hotel's spa, transforming three treatment rooms in the same coral pink tones with toile de Jouy Soleil design accents. The expansion of the collaboration into the spa this summer allows guests to enjoy six signature Dior face and body treatments.

HOTEL BEL-AIR, LOS ANGELES

Hotel Bel-Air launches its next chapter of culinary excellence under the direction of new culinary director, Michelin-starred Joe Garcia, with a renewed focus on local ingredients at The Restaurant and the introduction of two new culinary concepts set to debut in July: The Living Room, a new take on the quintessential Lobby Lounge experience serving afternoon tea, evening cocktails and small bites; and Patisserie, a nostalgic, French-inspired bakery elegantly presenting freshly baked pastries, breads and cakes.

A brand-new Dorchester ice cream trolley offers seasonal serves alongside a delicate adaptation of afternoon tea from The Promenade.

45 PARK LANE, LONDON

45 Park Lane welcomes back the renowned Champagne and hotdog concept Bubbledogs for a special alfresco pop-up at CUT Out this summer – 'Bubbledogs at 45'. The special menu features gourmet hotdogs and grower Champagne pairings, crafted in collaboration with 45 Park Lane's executive chef Elliott Grover and the culinary

minds behind Bubbledogs and two Michelin-starred Kitchen Table, Sandia Chang and James Knappett. Guests can indulge in this unique culinary experience daily for lunch and dinner until September 29.

COWORTH PARK, ASCOT
