- DESCRIPTION:** Nestled within 12 lush garden acres in one of the world's most exclusive neighborhoods, Hotel Bel-Air has been one of Hollywood's most beloved hideaways for nearly three quarters of a century. With its lush gardens, winding foot paths, covered archways and beloved Swan Lake, its enchanting setting and Spanish Colonial architecture blends LA's indoor and outdoor lifestyle. Pink stucco buildings spread among the property house 103 guestrooms and suites, as well as Canyon accommodations built up into the hillside. Master chef Wolfgang Puck oversees the hotel's entire culinary operation, including Wolfgang Puck at Hotel Bel-Air, the Bar and Lounge, in-room dining, and all functions and events. The

hotel's legendary oval-shaped pool and new Spa are also offered.

Each of the spacious and contemporary guest rooms features the finest decor and a range of innovative technology – from impressive Bang & Olufsen televisions to beautiful desks with integrated media hubs and iPads in every room. With 45 suites to choose from, including one-of-a-kind signature suites that offer grand residential style living, with large garden patios and fireplaces, the hotel has rooms to suit all tastes. For exceptional luxury, the impressive Presidential Suite has its own private courtyard and infinity pool, bed swathed in the finest Egyptian cotton, and a bar for those all-important social gatherings. For something a little less extravagant – but equally as elegant – the Canyon Suites offer supreme style and sophistication with a touch more privacy – not to mention some incredible views.

**ACCOMMODATIONS:**

Hotel Bel-Air features a total of 103 guestrooms and suites, including 58 rooms and 45 suites.

**GUESTROOMS &**

**SUITES:**

Deluxe guestrooms and suites are located throughout the property and will range from 335 – 535 interior square feet (guestrooms) and 537 – 1481 interior square feet (suites). The hotel uses a ground-breaking integrated technology system to enrich the guest experience, including iPad and touch screen Alcatel Lucent IP telephones allowing guests to order in-room dining and create the perfect ambience to suit their mood through the control of lighting and air conditioning facilities.

**LOFT GUESTROOMS:**

The three Loft guestrooms are located in the north section of the hotel in the Spa building and feature open floor plans, double sided gas fireplaces, retractable interior walls, 40” Bang and Olufsen high definition TV’s, and dramatic 13.5 foot high ceilings. Range from 650 – 790 interior square feet.

## CANYON VIEW ROOMS & SUITES:

The 12 contemporary hillside guestrooms and suites offer sweeping Canyon views, expansive retractable glass walls, outdoor fireplaces and spacious decks with private infinity edge spa pools.

## SPECIALTY SUITES:

The hotel's seven individually designed specialty suites include the Grace Kelly, Presidential, Chalon, Herb Garden, Swan Lake, Grand and Patio suite. All offer grand residential style living with large garden patios, fireplaces and some with Jacuzzi's. Suites range from 755 to 2260 interior square feet. Each will enjoy outdoor living space, from 210 to 4515 square feet.

The Presidential Suite compound offers 6,775 square feet of indoor and outdoor living space, with exceptional privacy within a graceful setting, with private dining for 10, a chef's kitchen, a study, great room with a grand piano, and a private pool located within a private Spanish courtyard.

**PRIVATE DINING ROOM:**

The restaurant's private dining room can accommodate 20 guests and is surrounded by multiple glass wine cellars displaying over 2400 bottles.

**THE TERRACE:**

The Terrace offers a garden dining experience, with a cocktail bar ideal for a light lunch or late-night dinner. Five private alcoves offer a different way to dine overlooking Swan Lake.

**THE BAR AND LOUNGE:**

The beloved Bar and Lounge is a cherished space among locals and travelers alike. The familiar wood paneling has been revived with a fresh new inviting look. The bar area now extends to the outdoors with intimate garden niches and fountains. Celebrities in black and white dominate the walls of The Bar and Lounge at Hotel Bel-Air, with iconic imagery captured by photography legend Norman Seeff.

**SOCIAL AND CORPORATE  
EVENTS:**

Hotel Bel-Air is a magnificent venue for meetings, conferences and special events with the latest technologies available throughout. The Garden Ballroom and Garden Ballroom Foyer & Courtyard have been completely reconfigured to host up to 250 people and flows perfectly between the inside and new outdoor elements. The interiors are designed with soft tones, allowing for each specific event to create its own color scheme. The Palm Room seats 14 for business meetings or can be easily transformed for intimate social events.

**WEDDINGS:**

A wedding at Hotel Bel-Air is truly a distinctive event. The Hotel Bel-Air offers a variety of garden ceremony options, including services on The Lawn, beside Swan Lake, or at any of the property's infamous courtyards, depending on the number of guests to be accommodated.

**RECREATION:**

The hotel's renowned oval swimming pool, at 10-feet deep and 80-feet long, is heated year-round and is open from 8 AM – 8 PM. Tennis, golf and other sporting facilities are available nearby upon request.

**GROUNDS:**

Many of the trees and lush vegetation found at Hotel Bel-Air are rarely seen in Southern California, such as the grove of coast redwoods, the 12- to 15-foot tall white flowering bird of paradise trees and the tipu tree above Chalon Road, which blooms into a cloud of yellow blossoms. Pink primrose, miniature yellow daffodils, lavender violas, white and purple hyacinths, pink tulips, white roses, red bougainvillea's, pink camellia bushes, red azaleas, flowering peach and apricot trees, gardenias, jasmine, roses and orange blossoms.

**HISTORY:**

Hotel Bel-Air has been a hideaway for world travelers for more than 65 years. A visionary significant in the development of the area, Alphonso E. Bell created Bel-Air Estates in 1922. Bell acquired over 600 acres west of the city of Los Angeles, naming his new purchase "Bel-Air." What is now the main center of the hotel was Bell's estate planning and sales offices which were located next to the Bel-Air Stables, where residents could board their horses and enjoy the miles of equestrian trails winding throughout the canyons.

For the next few decades, Bell's dream flourished. In 1946, Joseph Drown, a hotel entrepreneur from Texas, purchased 18 acres, and the land offices, and began plans to create an elegant pastoral hotel hideaway encompassing most of the land. Drown immediately hired architect Burton Schutt to convert the buildings and construct the 62 rooms of what was to become Hotel Bel-Air. Drown transformed the grounds into lush, beautiful gardens, adding Swan Lake to the picturesque front lawn. Drown also closed the Stone Canyon stables and built the sparkling oval-shaped pool at the site of the original riding ring. 29 more rooms and suites were added in the 1980's.
