## Rooms and suites

## Shopping

## Entertainment

Los Angeles' headliner is without doubt The Walt Disney Concert Hall. Designed by acclaimed LA-based architect Frank Gehry, the \$275million masterpiece stages performances by the Los Angeles Philharmonic Orchestra and touring performers throughout the year. The city boasts an exceptional range of concert venues, including the historic Hollywood Bowl, the Dolby Theatre – home of the Academy Awards Ceremony since 2002, and Universal Studios' Gibson Amphitheatre.

## Hiking

Our unique urban-rural location enables guests to explore miles of picturesque trails, which are ideal for hiking and picnicking. With 187-acres of high chaparral-swathed woodland, the Will Rogers State Historic Park

in the Pacific Palisades epitomises the savage beauty of southern California and is perfect for day-trips or afternoon outings. To the north west, Malibu Creek State Park offers 5,000-acres of breathtaking trails and wildlife. If you're in the mood for city views, head to Runyon Canyon in the foothills west of Hollywood.
