For your peace of mind, we're pleased to share some of the ways we're taking extra steps to ensure your health and safety during your visit.

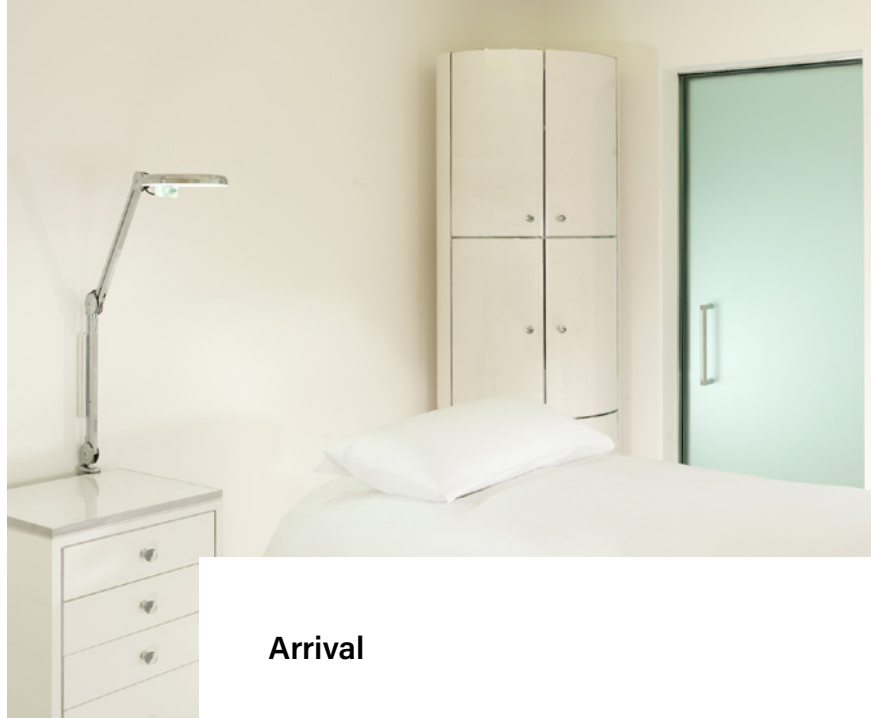
Before you arrive

If you or a member of your household is displaying symptoms of COVID-19, please refrain from visiting the spa for 14 days. If you've been asked to self-isolate, please let us know prior to your appointment. You can find more information at nhs.co.uk/conditions/coronavirus-covid-19.

To support social-distancing guidelines, we now have a booking system for all our spa facilities. The gym at The Dorchester can be pre-booked for 60-minute sessions.

If you'd like to reserve a table at The Spatisserie, please let us know at the time of booking.

Arrival

The government recommends the closure of changing rooms, so we ask that you arrive at the spa dressed in your robe and slippers (or fitness clothing for the gym), then return to the comfort of your room to shower. However, if you'd like to use a locker, we'll be happy to provide one with appropriate social distancing and sanitisation measures in place. Inside your locker you'll find towels, slippers and a robe.

We'll be happy to provide changing room amenities, including deodorant, hairspray, body lotion, disposable shower caps, cotton wool pads/buds and shaving kits on request. Bottled water will be available and hand towels provided on request, but headphones will no longer be offered. We've also removed newspapers and magazines from the relaxation areas, but these are available on our iPads if you'd like.

When you arrive, the spa reception team will check you in on the spa system and ask you to use the hand sanitiser before you enter the spa.

We are delighted to announce that we have reopened our steam rooms, which are located in both changing rooms. They are available for 15-minute sessions, which must be pre-booked with spa reception. We allow two guests inside at one time, and we recommend you use them before your treatments.





Social distancing and cleanliness

We ask that you maintain a safe distance from other guests and our colleagues where possible during your visit to the spa.

The gym will now need to be pre-booked for 60-minute slots, limited to four people at a time. It will then close for 15 minutes every hour to allow for the equipment to be sanitised after use and regularly throughout the day. Some equipment may be out of use in order to maintain social distancing.

Children

The Dorchester Spa does not permit children under the age of 16.

During your treatment

Our therapists will be wearing face masks, visors and gloves when performing your treatment, and you'll be asked to wear the disposable face covering provided. You'll also be asked to complete an electronic health form before your treatment.

We've fitted a glass screen on the manicure desk and will be using disposable equipment when possible.

For a breath of fresh air, Hyde Park's 350 acres are right on the doorstep, and we can provide running routes and nature walk maps for outdoor exercise.
