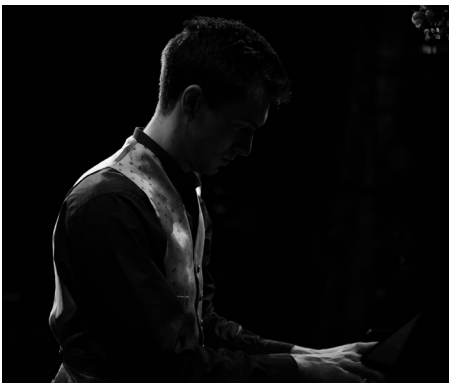


## Steve Bradford
