Veuve Clicquot Rosé

Madame Clicquot first blended Rosé in 1818 by adding some red wine to Yellow Label champagne. The result is a coppery-orange colour with expressive aromas of very ripe wild strawberries. A full-bodied, structured, vinous palate which stays fresh. Length and character define this champagne.
